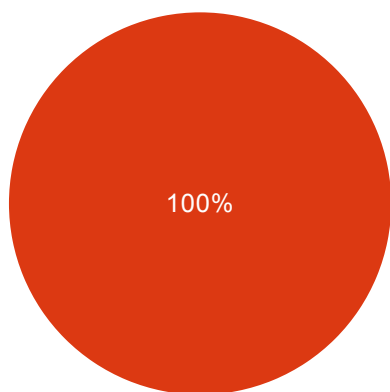

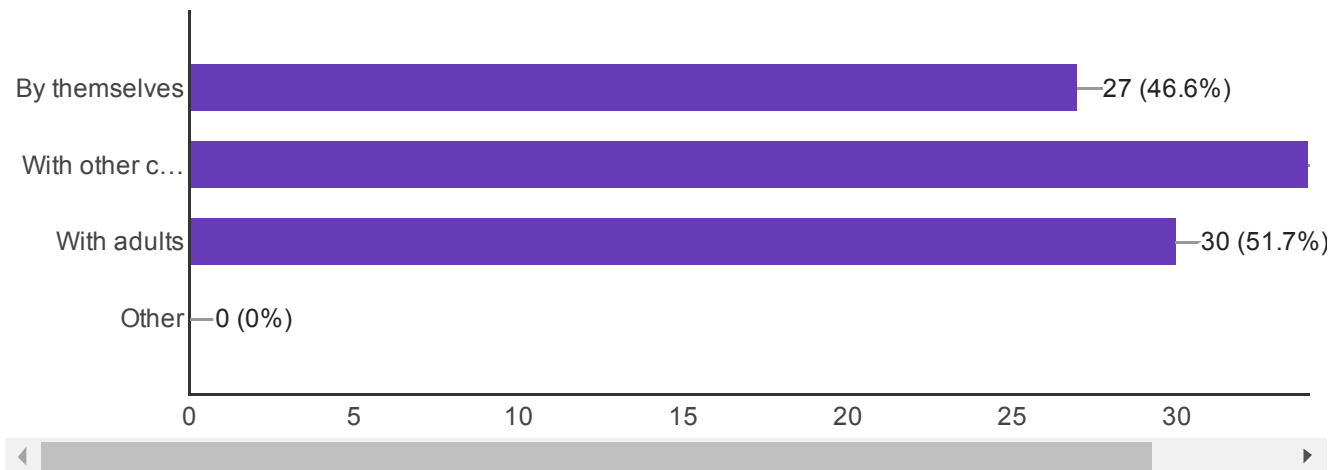

2. If so, how does your child usually get to Arlington Elementary School?

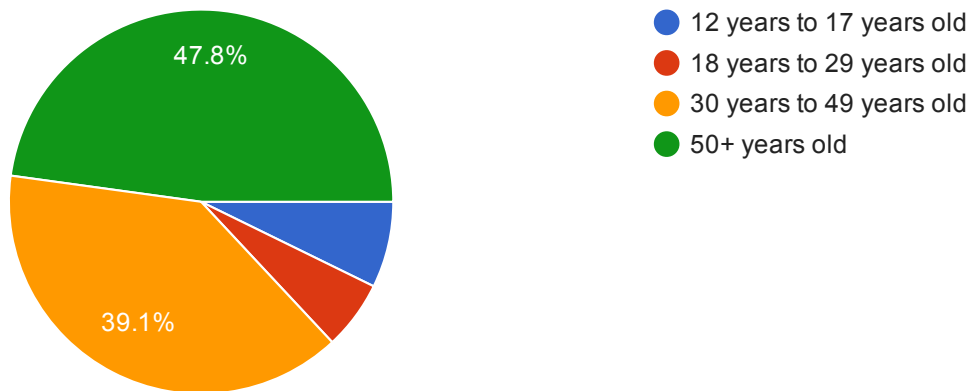

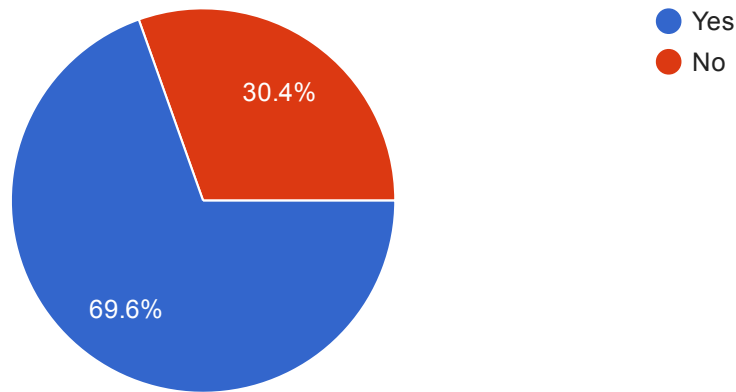

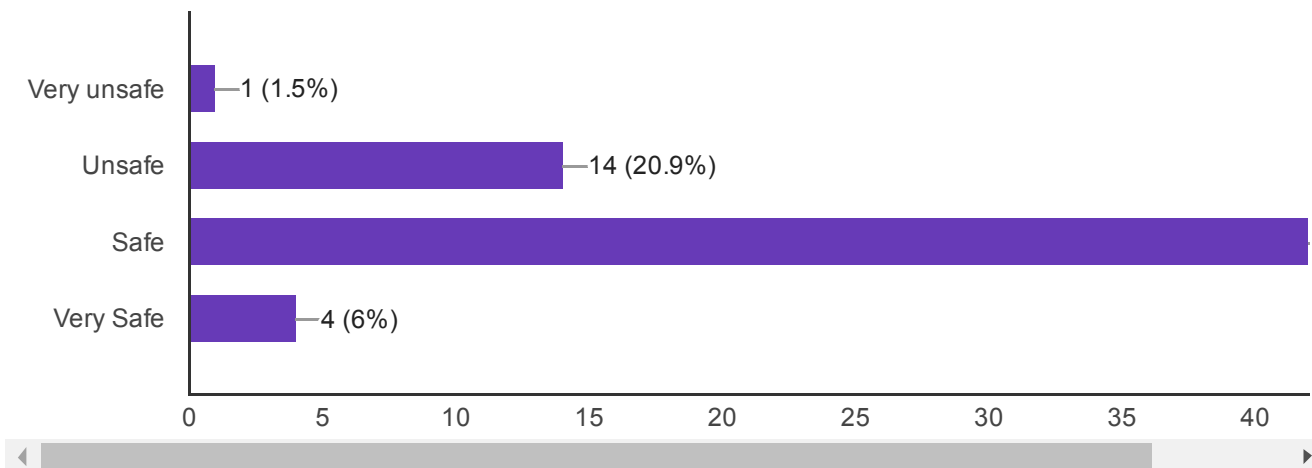

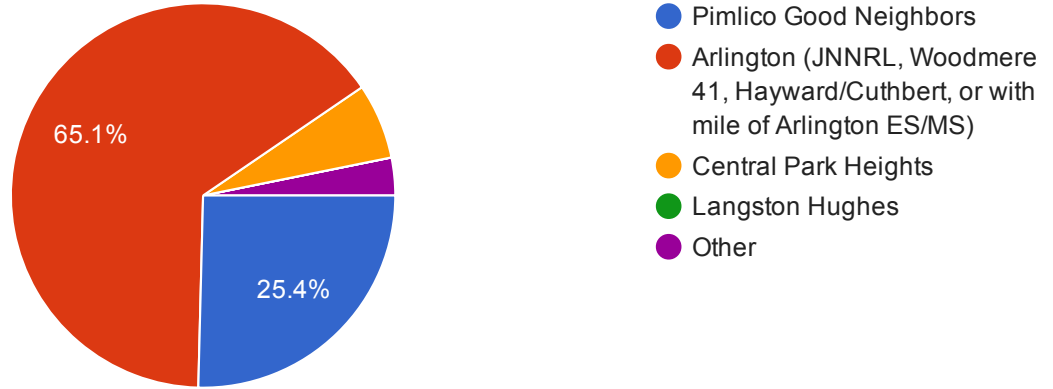

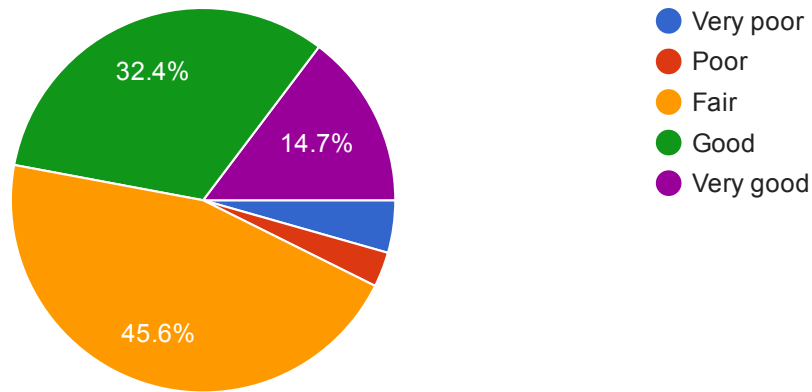
