The Baltimore City Public Ethics Law, contained in Article 8 of the City Code, requires many public servants to file annual financial disclosure statements by April 30 of each year. § 7-2. The Law requires each City agency to annually provide the Ethics Board with a list of the names and position numbers of public servants within that agency/board who are required to file. § 7-1.1(2). For the Local Development Council, the positions required to file are as follows:

§ 7-8. Persons required to file – Agency officials and staff.

(27a) Local Development Council, South Baltimore Video Lottery Terminal.

- (i) Members of the Council.
- (ii) All non-clerical employees of or assigned to the Council (any compensated official or employee who is not employed solely in a secretarial, clerical, or custodial capacity. § 7-6).
