




Middle Branch Waterfront

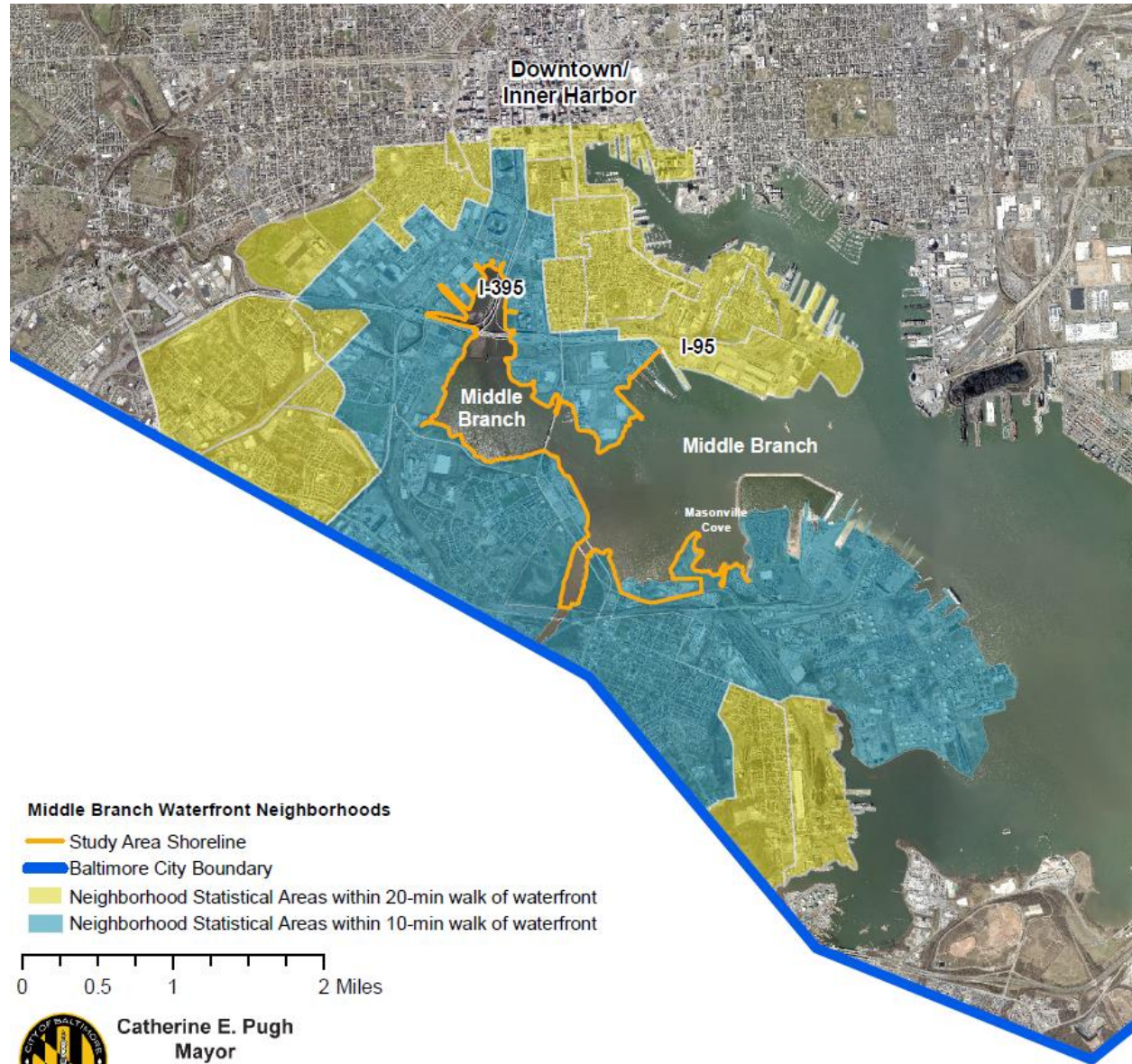
Creating a world-class recreational and environmental asset on the Patapsco River

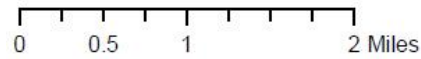
A transformed waterfront will generate opportunity for investment, while creating a new front yard for local neighborhoods.





Middle Branch Waterfront Neighborhoods

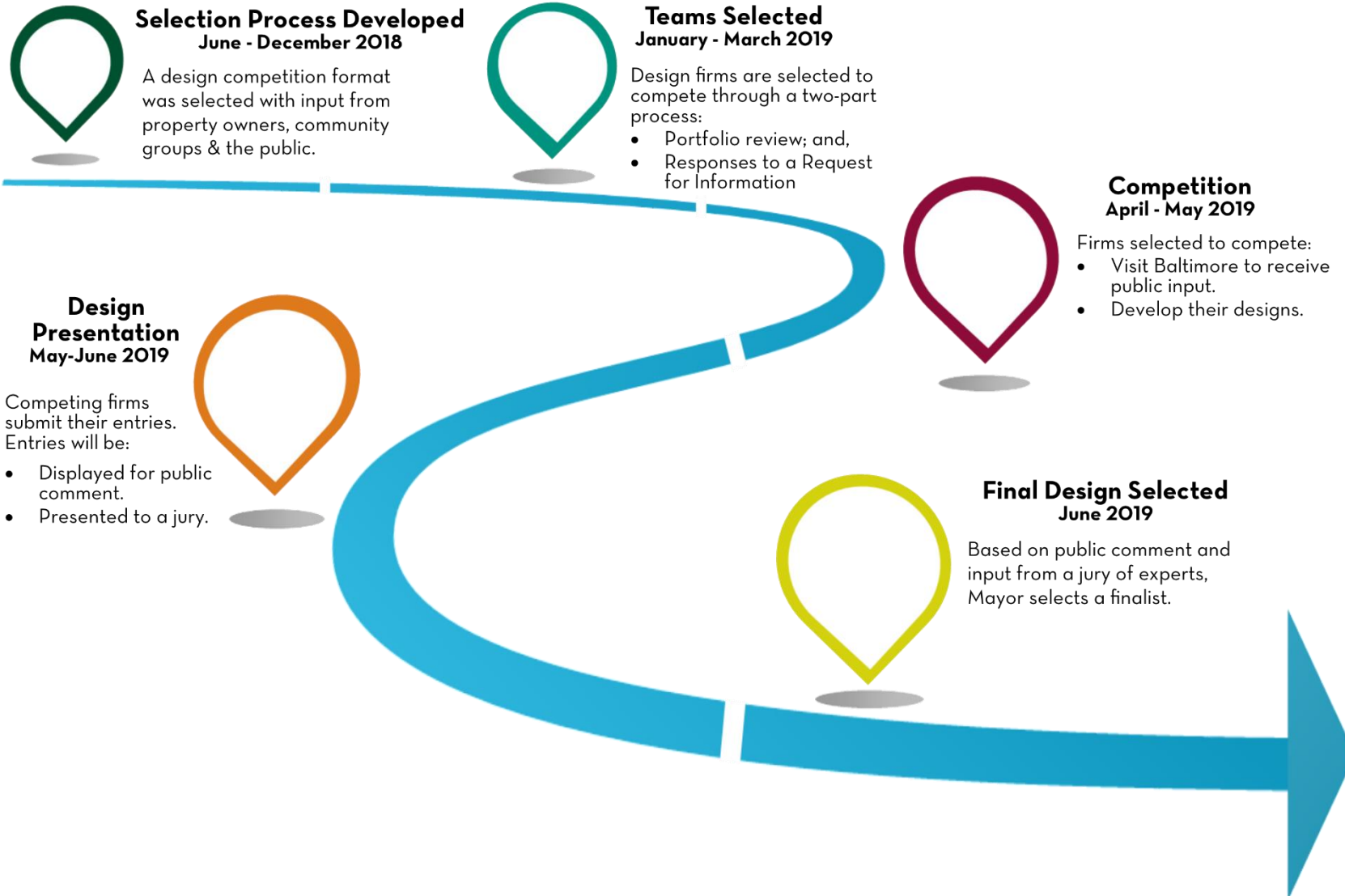
-  Study Area Shoreline

-  Neighborhood Statistical Areas within 10-min walk of waterfront



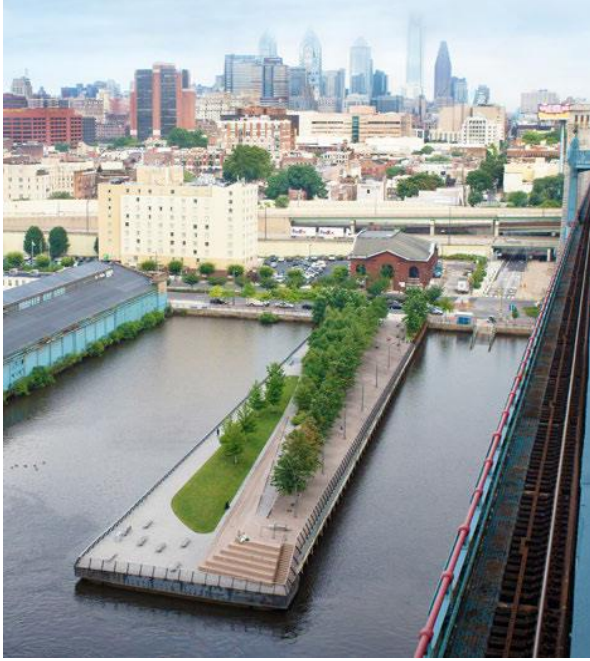

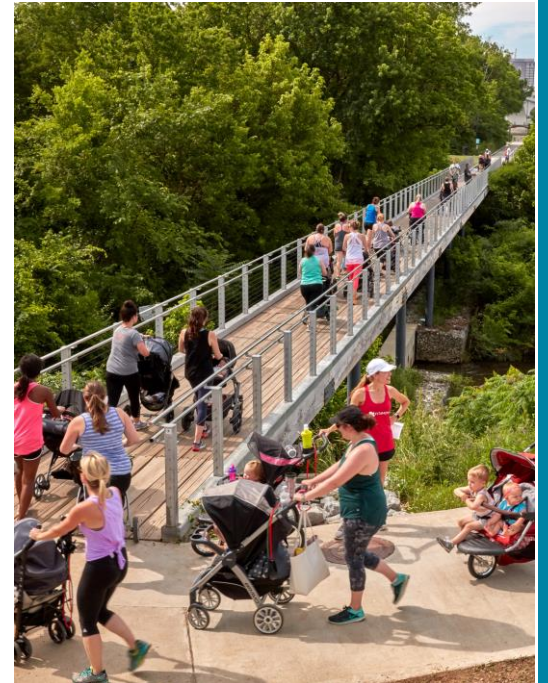
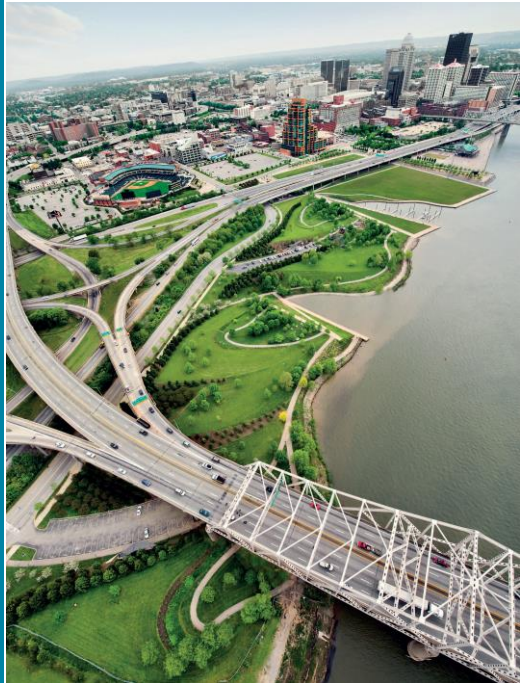
