About the Urban Design and Architecture Advisory Panel (UDAAP):

The Urban Design and Architecture Advisory Panel (UDAAP) provides the Planning Commission and the Department of Planning with design review expertise in the areas of urban design, architecture, and landscape design for all proposed master planning efforts and significant development projects. The goal of the panel is to help projects achieve high quality designs for the planned and built environment of Baltimore City.

The Panel consists of four (4) design professionals who are appointed at the discretion of the Director of Planning. The position is accompanied by a small stipend. Panelists are not employees of the City of Baltimore, but must comply with standards and rules of the Ethics Board, including completing the Pre-Appointment Disclosure Form.

About Design Review Authority in Baltimore City:

Design Review is required per Article 32 - Zoning Code, Title 4 — Development Reviews. Reviews may be conducted with Planning Staff and / or UDAAP. Certain aspects of the development review process are governed by the Baltimore City Design Manual, Landscape Manual, Site Plan Manual, and Article 32, while other aspects are more nuanced and site- or project-specific.

The various manuals and Zoning Code cannot regulate every aspect of a development project and are considered the baseline standards for architectural and urban design in Baltimore. Improved development outcomes occur from more nuanced site- and context-specific conversations during the design review process at both Planning Department staff and UDAAP level.

- Landscape Architecture
- Urban Design
- Historic Preservation

Preferred applicants will also have the following:

- Availability to meet virtually on Thursdays, approximately once per month, for full-day design review sessions;
- Familiarity with Baltimore City;
- The ability to provide timely, clear, and constructive feedback to development teams;
- Professional expertise and design review experience that sets them apart from their professional peers;
- Professional experience that will help improve development projects impact on Baltimore City's built environment.
